

## Firmware 1.21.0 for Hasselblad H6D

The 1.21.0 firmware is a feature release for all H6D cameras that adds new functionality.

### New features and Improvements compared to v1.20.1 (1.20.2 for H6D-400c MS):

- **Audio Notifications.**  
Audible signals for different events.
- **White Balance Tool**  
Set White Balance by using an eyedropper tool to pick a neutral area from any captured image.
- **Profiles**  
Store and recall all camera settings in 7 different Profiles.
- **Tethered image import**  
Import images from the memory cards of a USB tethered camera.
- **Reset All Settings**  
New option to disable the reset of Profiles.
- **Shut-down message**  
A message will be shown on the display, when the camera is shutting down.
- **Browse Zoom**  
Long-press on the True Focus button zooms in to 100% or out to full image.
- **HDMI panning**  
When a HDMI monitor is connected, you can use the rear screen as touch-pad for panning in the zoomed-in image.

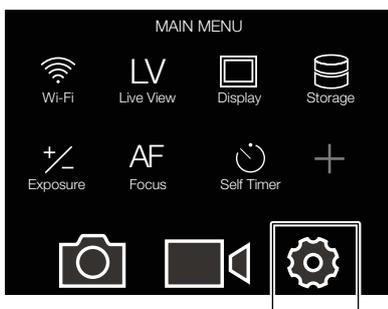
### Update procedure

Make sure that you use a fully charged battery on the camera. A charge level of 50% or more is required. Please note that the update procedure normally takes about 7-10 minutes, but can in some cases take up to 12 minutes.

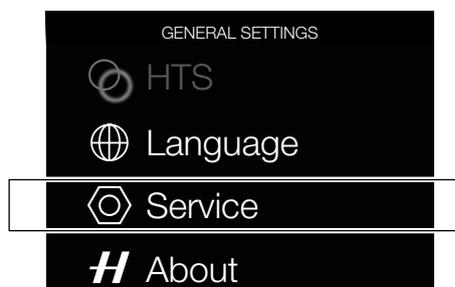
### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- It is not allowed to have the USB cable inserted during the update process.
- Wait until the message “Update Finished” is shown. Then remove and reinsert the battery.

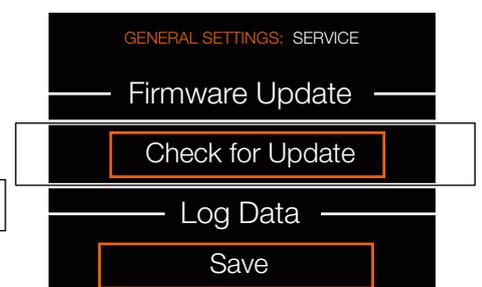
Copy the downloaded file (H6D\_v1\_21\_0.cim) to the memory card and insert it into the camera. Then follow the procedure below:



1: Select the “General Settings Menu” from the main menu.



2: Select “Service”



3: Click “Check for Update” and select the file “H6D\_v1\_21\_0.cim” from the list. Finally click “Update”.
