

Firmware 0.5.40 for Hasselblad XCD Lenses

The 0.5.40 firmware is a feature and maintenance release aimed for the XCD Lenses. It should be used on all XCD Lenses.

Improvements since 0.5.33:

- **Support for the XCD 35-75 Zoom**
Adds full support for the XCD 35-75 lens.
- **Improved AF for XCD 65 and XCD 80**
Focus drive direction change has been made smoother and the AF speed of the XCD 65 has been increased.
- **Improved manual focus control**
Precision when focusing manually in vertical orientation has been improved.
Fine-tuned the Auto-Zoom function as it was sometimes triggered too easily by the focusing ring.

Bug fixes since 0.5.33:

- **Tethered Micro-step issue**
Solved a bug where focus control from Phocus only worked in one direction if divided scan range was enabled.

Update procedure

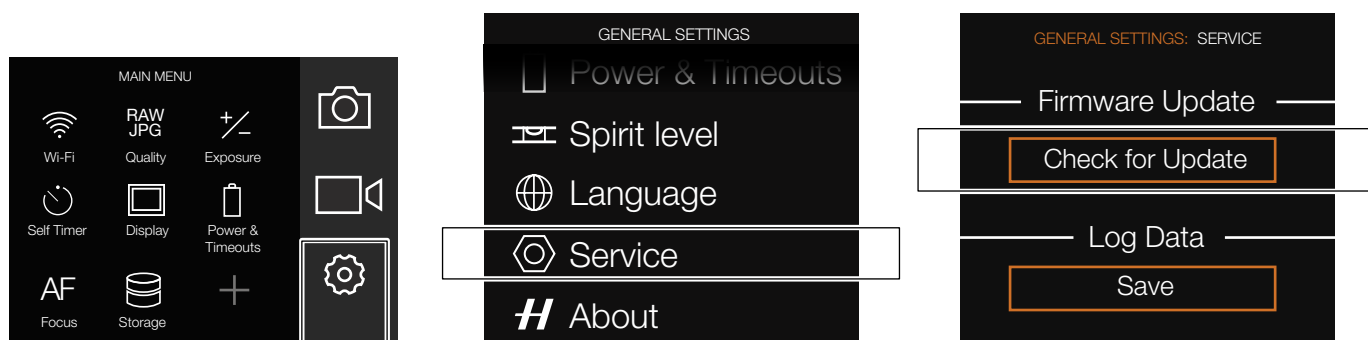
Mount the lens on the camera to perform the update.

Make sure that you use a fully charged battery on the camera. A charge level of 50% or more is required. Please note that the update procedure normally takes up to 1 minute.

Note: It is not allowed to have the USB cable inserted during the update process.

Note: Once the update is completed you must remove and reinsert the battery.

Copy the downloaded file (X-Lens_v0_5_40.cim) to the SD card and insert it into the camera. Then follow the procedure below:



1: Select the "Settings Menu" from the main menu.

2: Select "Service".

3: Click "Check for update" and select the file "X-Lens_v0_5_40.cim" from the list. Finally click "Upgrade".

Repeat the process for all XCD Lenses.
